The PARL Department desires to conduct virtual training for PARL leaders and their team in Lake Region Conference.

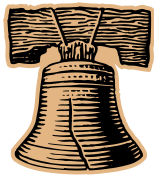
Elder Paul Young, LRC

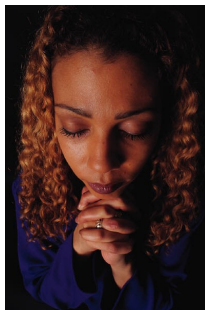
